Performs field and office work necessary to document land survey data, GPS data, and location of utility infrastructure; Researches land deed records to assist in land acquisition process Current license in Ohio is required. Performs survey work as requested for topographic mapping, real property boundary surveys and maps, preparation of legal descriptions, construction staking, encroachment issues, and miscellaneous survey requests. Performs data collection, analysis, compilation, dissemination, and preparation of records and reports pertaining to survey and GPS data. Maintains records pertaining to boundary encroachments. Coordinates and reviews services performed by professional surveying and other related consulting firms. Coordinates and manages volunteers working on boundary monitoring. Performs job duties in accordance with Great Parks of Hamilton County's policies, procedures, and performance expectations.

### QUALIFICATIONS

An appropriate combination of education, training, course work and experience may qualify an applicant to demonstrate required knowledge, skills, and abilities. An example of an acceptable qualification is: Bachelor's Degree in Land Surveying or related field and 4 years of field and office experience working under direct supervision of a licensed professional surveyor including experience in AutoCAD, ArcGIS and GPS related applications. Ability to document identity and employment eligibility within three (3) days of original appointment as a condition of employment in compliance with Immigration Reform and Control Act requirements.

Registration as a Professional Surveyor in the State of Ohio; State Motor Vehicle Operator's License that meets GPHC current carrier guidelines.
