This Full-Time position will work under the direction of a Professional Surveyor associated with all aspects of land surveying. Candidates must have strong field experience along with some office experience.

Job Description:

This position is responsible for the primary field direction of projects assigned to them. Directing all duties of field survey members assigned to them while performing calculations. Use of both proper field checks and practices, while having open communication between the office & the field is a must. Experience managing a survey crew is preferred. Lead survey crew providing direction & leadership by demonstrating an attitude for safety, efficiency and professionalism while on the job.

Projects work will encompass the following areas of surveying:

Boundary, Construction staking, ALTA, Right of Way Mapping, topographic surveys, and other duties.

Qualifications: The employee may be required to push, pull, lift, and/or carry up to 80 pounds.

Work may routinely require the employee to climb, balance, bend, stoop, kneel, crouch, and/or crawl. Work is performed under all weather conditions, often on busy streets, or construction sites, involves extensive standing and walking and includes clearing brush, working in difficult terrain, opening manholes and on periodic difficult slopes.

Candidate should have direct knowledge of use of Trimble Robotic Total Stations, GPS, & SurveyPro software. Experience with Construction staking, field calculations, and plan reading is required. The position will mostly be a field-based position with opportunity for office growth. Candidate must be willing to travel for out of town work, up to once a month if requested, and field work will be performed in both urban and rural areas.

Education: Prefer Candidate would be a S.I.T. working toward P.S. license. But post-secondary technical training in surveying, including two-year associate degree or technology degree is acceptable. Relevant experience and training may be substituted for a college degree.

Experience: 3-4 years of progressively more responsible work experience on a survey crew, including at least 2 years as an Instrument Operator and comfortable with construction stakeout. Must possess a valid driver's license, ability to safely operate a motor vehicle, ability to read, write, and perform basic math. Must be comfortable communicating with the public, and must be available to work in all types of indoor and outdoor environments. Must be able to pass a drug test and background check if requested.
