

TOLEDO CHAPTER PROFESSIONAL LAND SURVEYORS OF OHIO, INC.
ANNUAL SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS
RULES AND QUALIFICATIONS

PURPOSE:

The purpose of the Toledo Chapter of the Professional Land Surveyors of Ohio (PLSO) Scholarship is to honor and promote those students seeking a career in surveying who will support and represent Ohio and the PLSO surveying standards of the future.

GENERAL:

The Toledo Chapter PLSO shall present, annually, scholarship awards to pay towards tuition expenses of students qualified as described below. These scholarships will be available to students preparing for their second year of a Surveying Degree/Certificate Program at an Associate Degree Technical School level or their Junior or Senior years at a four year Bachelor of Science level.

ELIGIBILITY:

1. The student must be enrolled in a Surveying-related Degree/Certificate Program at a state accredited college or university.
2. The student must be prepared for, and these monies used, in their second year of a two year Technical Surveying-related Program; or the Junior or Senior year of a four year Bachelor of Science Surveying Program.
3. The student must have an accumulated grade point average of 2.50 or above (based on a 4.0 point system).
4. The student must be recommended for this award by a faculty member within the surveying department of the student's school or by a PLSO Toledo Chapter member.
5. The student should show a continued drive to become a practicing surveyor and exhibit those qualities which are essential in becoming a professional person.
6. Preference will be given to a Student Member of PLSO.
7. A maximum of two (2) scholarships in the amount of \$1,000.00 each will be awarded annually to those students who are enrolled in a Bachelor of Science Surveying Program. A maximum of two (2) scholarships in the amount of \$750.00 each will be awarded annually to those students who are enrolled in a two year Technical Surveying-related Program.
8. No student may receive more than two (2) Toledo Chapter scholarships.
9. Scholarships will be awarded at the discretion of the Scholarship Committee, based on available funding.
10. Minimum of three (3) credit hours is required to be eligible for consideration.

STUDENT APPLICATION:

A student may inquire as to the procedure involved in applying for a Toledo Chapter PLSO Scholarship through the offices of his/her school faculty or advisor, through his/her local student chapter of PLSO or through the Toledo Chapter web site (www/plsotoledo.org) . Completed application forms and other requested materials shall be submitted to the Surveying Faculty Advisor or Surveying Department by October 20 of each year. A chapter screening committee shall evaluate the applications, determine eligibility, and make recommendations to the Toledo Chapter PLSO no later than the November meeting. Application forms will be available from the Toledo Chapter web site (www/plsotoledo.org) or through the Surveying Department of their school.

SELECTION COMMITTEE:

The Toledo Chapter PLSO Selection Committee will be comprised of the President and the following members of the Toledo Chapter PLSO: the Chairman of the Scholarship Committee, the Trig Star Program Chairman, the President-Elect and the immediately available Past President. The Selection Committee will be responsible for reviewing and verifying the applications and faculty recommendations submitted by the students seeking the PLSO Scholarships and to make the final recommendations.

AWARD:

At the Toledo Chapter's regular November meeting, the Selection Committee shall present to the Chapter, the names of students recommended for the awards. The Chapter members in attendance shall either approve or reject the recommendations of the Selection Committee at the same November meeting. The announcement of the awards to the recipients of the scholarships shall then be made by the President of the Toledo Chapter PLSO as soon as possible thereafter. The recognition of the awards to the recipients shall be made by the President of the Toledo Chapter PLSO at the December meeting. These scholarships shall be paid directly to the school in the name of the student by December 20. In addition to the scholarship, a year's membership to the PLSO will be given to the selected students.
